Who is the service for?	The service is for Bromley Residents with a formal diagnosis of Dementia from their Doctor
Accessing service	To get access Dementia Respite at Home services, please contact 0208 461 7777 (London Borough of Bromley contact number) and ask to be referred to the service.

Charging	Anyone accessing the Dementia Respite at home service will have a means tested financial assessment to find out if they can get any local Government funding towards the cost of the service.
	The service charges are £19.14 per hour with a weekly administrative fee of £5.53 per week. If you already have an existing care package with Bromley in place you might not be charged for this service. You will however still need to have a financial assessment to determine this.
How long will it take for the service to start?	We aim to make a decision within 10 days of you completing the financial assessment. This is subject to you providing all information requested so there is no delay in the service getting back to you.
